WHAT MAKES US UNIQUE?

St. Anne's is an independent British school in Chamartín, Madrid. Children join us at one year old and can stay until they leave for university at eighteen, on a single site, with teachers who know them by name. Founded in 1969 as a family school, it is still independent, still on the same site and still small enough for the Principal to know every pupil.

We follow the British National Curriculum alongside Spanish Language, Literature and Social Studies. Pupils sit Cambridge and Pearson Edexcel IGCSEs at sixteen years old and go on to the IB Diploma Programme, which gives direct access to university. All our teachers are native speakers of the language in which they teach, and reading and mathematics are taught with Read Write Inc. phonics and White Rose Maths, the programmes used in strong British primary schools.

Every family receives a monthly call from their child's tutor and a reply to any message within 24 hours. Mobile phones are prohibited on the school premises, at every age.

OUR VISION

Our vision is to be a leading British school in Madrid, recognised for excellence in teaching, innovation and student wellbeing.

We work every day to create a vibrant and challenging environment in which our students discover their passions, interests and strengths, and grow as individuals. We

want them to think freely, to find the confidence to lead, and to keep the humility to serve.

Our ethos, rooted in the philosophy of Catholic education, has guided the school since 1969. St. Anne's welcomes families of all faiths and none.

OUR VALUES

Respect: we learn from our differences and look after each other and the place we share.

Kindness: noticing what someone else needs and acting on it. It is the quality families most often mention about our pupils.

Integrity: doing the right thing when nobody is checking, and having the

courage to say so when something is wrong.

Curiosity: asking why, testing an idea, reading one more page. Our teaching is built to keep that instinct alive.

Teamwork: Houses, the Student Council, Debate Club and CAS projects: pupils learn to lead and to follow.

BE PRESENT

Mobile phones are prohibited on the school premises, for every pupil from Pre-Nursery to Year 13. Break times are for playing and talking; lessons are for the people in the room.



THE HISTORY OF ST. ANNE'S SCHOOL

St. Anne's School was established in 1969 and is a co-educational independent school which provides a British education for children from one to eighteen years old in Madrid. The school is located on Avenida de Alfonso XIII, in Chamartín, one of the most attractive residential areas of the city, and is easily accessible from most of Madrid.

St. Anne's has been part of the British school community in Spain since 1969, as a founder member of the National Association of British Schools in Spain (NABSS). The school is accredited by the British Council and inspected by the

NABSS Inspection Service at every stage, from Pre-Nursery to Year 13, with authorisation for 650 pupils, and is an authorised IB World School for the Diploma Programme.

That accreditation is what assures families that the curriculum, the teaching and the facilities meet the standards expected of a British school in the United Kingdom. At the last inspection, the inspectors wrote that the nature and ethos of the school are "clearly recognisably British in all aspects of the school, mirroring what would be found in the independent sector in the UK".

THE BRITISH EDUCATION SYSTEM

We follow the British National Curriculum from Early Years to Year 11, with Spanish Language, Literature and Social Studies taught alongside it, and the IB Diploma Programme in Years 12 & 13. External examinations include Cambridge and Pearson Edexcel IGCSEs, the IB DP and Cambridge English qualifications.

Progress is measured with the assessment tools used in British schools: Cambridge BASE and CEM in Primary and MIDYIS in Secondary. Most of our teachers are UK qualified and all are native English speakers, and our pupil-teacher ratio of 7:1 allows every child to be known, supported and stretched.

PRE-NURSERY

Children join us from one year old, for a morning session (09:00 to 12:30) or a full day (09:00 to 16:00). English is the language of the classroom from the first morning, and the room is built around a very small child: routines, play, songs, and adults who notice everything.

Our objective is a caring, nurturing environment in which children feel safe enough to try things. We work closely with each family during the settling-in period, and the tutor calls home every month.

St. Anne's is accredited by the British Council as a British school from Pre-Nursery upwards, for children from one year old, and we accept cheque guardería from the main providers in Spain. Four years ago there were four children in Pre-Nursery. This year more than seventy families have chosen it.

What a child takes from Pre-Nursery

Understanding and first words in English, confidence with other children and with adults, independence in small everyday things, and the building blocks for Nursery: listening, sharing, holding a crayon, finishing a task.

EARLY YEARS

Our Early Years Foundation Stage comprises Nursery (3 to 4 years old) and Reception (4 to 5 years old). We learn through play, with clear goals behind it. Reading begins with **Read Write Inc.** phonics and mathematics with **White Rose Maths**, the programmes used in strong British primary schools, so that every child builds secure foundations in English from the very beginning.

By the end of their two years with us, children have formed strong bonds with their peers, a real awareness of what they can do and a desire to learn more. They leave Reception reading, writing, adding and subtracting, ready for Year 1.

Classes are led by early-years specialists who are native English speakers, supported by our school psychologist. We make a special effort to ensure that children feel at home and adapt to school life easily, while encouraging autonomy and independence.

How we teach reading

Read Write Inc. teaches children the sounds of English before the letters, in small groups matched to each child's stage. Progress is checked every few weeks, so no child is left waiting.



WHAT WE PROMISE

1. Children feel safe and happy, have fun and enjoy learning, knowing that they are cared for.
2. Pupils are immersed in English from the moment they enter St. Anne's; it is the vehicle for their learning.
3. Children develop their confidence and abilities with our expert staff through creative, imaginative, physical and academic activities, nurturing their social and emotional intelligence.
4. We make a special effort to ensure that children feel at home and adapt to school life as easily as possible, while encouraging autonomy and independence.
5. We encourage a positive attitude to study which will benefit each child throughout their school years and beyond.
6. We tell parents, plainly and often, how their child is doing: a monthly call from the tutor and a reply to any message within 24 hours.



5 TO 11 YEARS OLD



PRIMARY

Primary runs from Year 1 to Year 6 in two Key Stages: Key Stage 1 from Year 1 to Year 3, and Key Stage 2 from Year 4 to Year 6. Reading and writing continue with **Read Write Inc.** and mathematics with **White Rose Maths**, and progress is measured each year with Cambridge BASE and CEM assessments, so we can show parents exactly where their child is and what comes next.

Our guiding principles throughout the Primary school are:

Academic Excellence: high levels of achievement through targeted goal setting and a “can do” attitude.

Creative Thinkers: stimulating practical tasks in which pupils challenge ideas, predict outcomes and draw conclusions.

Communicative Participators: carefully planned pair and group tasks in which children discuss, debate and reach decisions every day. The Debate Club now starts in Primary.

Growth Mindset: children learn that their abilities grow through effort, application and experience.

Integrated Role Models: older pupils look after younger ones as House Captains, Playground Monitors and Special Friends.

Beyond the Curriculum: trips, workshops and residential, the House System with House Points, and a redesigned programme of after-school activities.

Close to Families: continuous monitoring of each child's academic and social development, a monthly call from the tutor, a reply to any message within 24 hours, and a school psychologist who works with individual children and whole classes.



KEY STAGE 1 (YEARS 1–3)

An engaging curriculum delivered by an experienced, fully qualified team of native English-speaking teachers. Our approach is designed for children to enjoy a happy and secure learning environment where they are valued; to develop lively, enquiring minds where they question rather than

merely accept; and to acquire knowledge and skills they can transfer to other subjects and situations.

We recognise that emotional health is important for academic achievement, therefore PSHE forms an integral part of our school week.

KEY STAGE 2 (YEARS 4–6)

Upper Primary develops children's established skills and widens their experience across every subject. Here the British National Curriculum is brought alive through a passionate

and creative approach, while academic excellence stays at the forefront of our teaching.

At the end of Key Stage 2 our pupils sit the English SATs.

11 TO 16 YEARS OLD



SECONDARY

After their preparation in Primary, the Secondary department delivers a British education to students in Years 7 to 11. Subjects are taught by specialist teachers in subject rooms, and pupils are supported by a tutor who follows their academic and personal progress closely and keeps in regular contact with their family.

In the final two years of Secondary, our students prepare for the official Cambridge and Pearson Edexcel IGCSE examinations, recognised worldwide. St. Anne's is an examination centre for both boards. The Student Council, Debate Club and the Duke of Edinburgh's International Award give pupils responsibility beyond the timetable, and the school day is phone-free.

Each student sat nine or ten subjects. 44% of our students achieved four or more A*-A grades and 52% achieved three or more. The UK average for GCSE grades at 7/A or above in 2026 was 22.0% (JCQ).



KEY STAGE 3 (YEARS 7–9)

In Key Stage 3, pupils develop a deeper knowledge and understanding of the subjects taught and acquire more complex skills. They are taught by our team of specialist teachers in subject-based rooms and learn to organise their books and materials in a more independent way.

Small class sizes allow teachers to focus on each individual and to develop a working partnership with pupils and parents through feedback and reporting. During these years pupils find out which subjects they enjoy most and where their talents lie, which helps them choose well for IGCSE.

KEY STAGE 4 (YEARS 10–11)

IGCSE courses are taught through Years 10 and 11, with examinations in May and June of the second year, set and marked by Pearson Edexcel and Cambridge. Most pupils study nine or ten subjects, some compulsory and others optional, and our aim is to help each of them achieve as many quality passes as possible before the IB Diploma Programme.

Our teachers focus on the set syllabi and required standards, while pupils continue to learn through exploration, investigation, creativity and practical application. Small groups mean teachers know their students well and give them the individual attention they need to reach their goals.



16 TO 18 YEARS OLD



SIXTH FORM

IB DIPLOMA PROGRAMME • YEARS 12 & 13

During their two years in Sixth Form, our students follow the International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme, a rigorous and internationally recognised pre-university course. Students study six subjects, three at Higher Level, together with Theory of Knowledge, the Extended Essay and Creativity, Activity, Service (CAS). Spanish A is offered, so students can earn the Bilingual Diploma.

The IB Diploma Programme gives our students direct access to university. Our first cohort graduated in May 2026 and every one of them was placed at their first-choice university, in Spain and in the United States.

We help our students develop the skills they will need in the world ahead, where empathy, creativity, teamwork and a critical spirit will be especially prized. We do this by making sure every student is valued and given strong individual support, including:

1. A strong team of subject specialists: most of our teachers are UK qualified and all are native English speakers.
2. Regular one-to-one meetings with tutors for individual guidance.
3. Preparation for Cambridge Proficiency and IELTS.
4. Small class sizes.
5. Personalised university and careers guidance, so that students know the opportunities open to them and choose well.

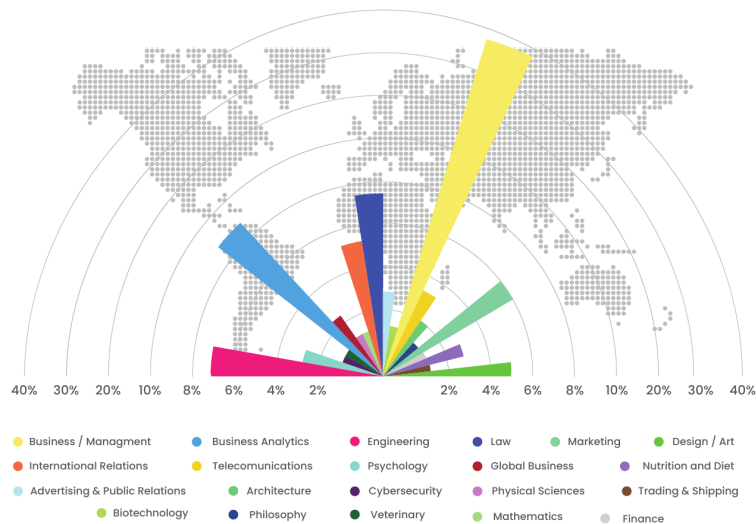

SCHOOL LIFE

A school of 300 has to choose what it does well. This year we have redesigned the extracurricular programme with a specialist provider with more than thirty years' experience, for every age, including yoga and pilates for parents.

Sport and Houses: a new PE model in which neighbouring year groups train together, and the House System with House Points across the whole school, from Reception to Year 13.

Voice and Service: the Debate Club runs from Primary to Sixth Form; the Student Council gives pupils a real say; the Duke of Edinburgh's International Award and the IB's CAS programme take them into Madrid, working with eight community organisations.

The Building: two science laboratories, three IB classrooms, a gymnasium, an art room and a library: fifteen specialist rooms in all. Meals are cooked in our own kitchen, a school bus serves the city, and a medical service and school psychologist are on site.

Be Present: mobile phones are prohibited on the school premises, at every age, so that attention stays in the room.
